For the fourth time in five days, WestJet has experienced a bomb threat against our aircraft. Tonight, flight #WS722 from Vancouver to Toronto was diverted to Calgary International Airport out of an abundance of caution. Like the other three incidents, no bomb was found and the aircraft was cleared by police and returned to us. This was yet another hoax.

We worked closely tonight with the Calgary Airport Authority and Calgary Police Service to ensure the safety of our guests and crew and we thank our partners for their hard work and dedication. We also thank our guests for their patience and understanding, as they resume their journey tonight on other WestJet flights.

We understand and appreciate that four false threats in five days is generating a great deal of interest and unfortunately, rumour and speculation. We will not comment on these rumours nor will we share information about how we handle these incidents, for obvious reasons. We will continue to work closely with law enforcement to find those responsible. Safety remains our top priority and we will continue to be vigilant to keep our guests and our crews safe.
